Tosti, Prosecco (3) U 8.50 25.95

Veneto, Italy (11%)

Delicate, with a perfumed bouquet of pear, apple and citrus fruits. A crisp off-dry palate boasts fresh and fruity flavours, which are enhanced by a balancing swirl of minerality.

Paul Langier Champagne Brut (1) U 35.95

Champagne, France (12.5%)

A hidden gem, stylish brut Champagne offering ripe fruit notes with a classic biscuity finish. A careful blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay grapes come together to produce this outstanding cuvée. Vegan friendly.

Heidsieck & Co Monopole Blue Top Champagne (2) U 39.95

Champagne, France (12%)

Lively and light yellow with highlights; on the nose it is rich, toasty and buttery. A full, fruity and well-structured combination of blackcurrant, lemon and slight yeastiness. It is lively and moreish, a superb aperitif - Vegan friendly

Vamonos, Sauvignon Blanc (3) n v r 4.95 6.25 8.20 23.00

Central Valley, Chile (12.5%)

Zesty with a crisp, refreshing acidity. Strong aromas of field herbs, gooseberry and lemon on the nose, with slight hints of melon and grapefruit coming through on the palate.

The Citrus Tree, Chardonnay (2) g d x 5.10 6.50 8.50 24.00

South Eastern Australia (12.5%)

A refreshing and crisp Chardonnay packed with grapefruit, lime and melon flavours, all bound in a zesty citrus balance which cuts through to the finish.

Casa de Rossa, Pinot Grigio (2) n v r 5.10 6.50 8.50 24.00

Veneto, Italy (12%)

Lemony on the nose, with a delicious balance in the mouth, this Pinot Grigio is a very easy to drink dry white, with a sublime lingering finish reminiscent of fresh garden herbs and peach.

Mack & Collie, Sauvignon Blanc (2) u q v 5.50 7.00 9.80 28.00

Marlborough, New Zealand (12%)

A herby, bright Sauvignon, brimming with crisp acidity and tangy citrus flavours. On the nose, some tropical fruits burst through, adding depths of passionfruit and melon to the wine. Great with fish and chips!

Quinta da Lixa, QL Vinho Verde (2) n v r 25.00

Vinho Verde, Portugal (10.5%)

Perfect lunch time tippie! A fresh and well-balanced wine, with fruity and floral aromas of apple, grapefruit and herbal notes. Medium-bodied and refreshing, with the classic Vinho Verde touch of spritz. | Vegan Friendly

Roquemolière, Picpoul de Pinet Réserve (1) u q 28.00

Languedoc, France (12.5%)

The wine is crisp, light and aromatic, with remarkable freshness on the palate. Classic and charming – the perfect summertime tippie.

Ramón Bilbao, Albariño - (2) n v r 32.50

Rias Baixas, Spain (12.5%)

On the nose, tropical notes of pineapple and passion fruit intersperse with golden apple and stone fruits. A refined palate displays nuances of apricot, mango and a delicious tropical fruit finish.
